H-CAP Education Association comprises industry-driven, labor-management, and labor-based training organizations in 16 states plus Washington, DC, representing 550,000 workers.

H-CAP EA is a non-profit 501c3 that supports work across sectors of the healthcare industry. H-CAP EA supports leadership and staff development for Funds and Training organizations, and is able to support the work of partner funds in areas including apprenticeships, language classes for English Language Learners, and exam preparation.

H-CAP EA is governed by directors of partner labor management training funds, with an advisory committee composed of training fund representatives, with representation across all sectors of the healthcare industry – from hospitals and health systems to nursing homes, home care and ambulatory and community-based care.
